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### **DESCRIPTION OF COURSES**

#### **PSY 834 Doctoral Project Seminar (Psy.D.)**

This seminar provides a structured framework for the development of the Psy.D. doctoral project. Quantitative, methodological, and ethical issues relevant to students' research proposals are discussed. Fully developed research proposals are presented to faculty and peers and subjected to rigorous review. Implementation of their proposed research is contingent upon faculty approval.

#### **PSY 835 Doctoral Colloquium (Psy.D.)**

This seminar provides a provides a structured framework for the completion of the Psy.D. doctoral project. Issues regarding the statistical analyses and interpretation of research findings are of primary concern for discussion. Research results are presented to faculty and peers and are rigorously critiqued. The completion of their Psy.D. doctoral project is contingent upon faculty approval.

*Psy 834* students are required to attend both **class meetings** and 2 of 3 **Psy.D. Presentation days**. *Psy 835* students are required to attend both **class meetings** and all day on the **Psy.D. Presentation** date they are scheduled to present their results.
