Note 1

Two weeks prior to the date you wish to present, you must submit (a) approval forms, signed by your advisor and consultant (needed for **both** *Psy 834* and *Psy 835*), and (b) *15 copies* and *one disk copy* (either Microsoft Word or WordPerfect format) of a 2000-3000 word (approximately 7-10 pages with 11 point font size) doctoral project proposal (for *Psy 834*) or doctoral project results summary (for *Psy 835*). I will provide information regarding the structure of these papers.

Note 2

Psy 834 students are required to attend both **class meetings** and 2 of 3 **Psy.D. Presentation days**. *Psy 835* students are required to attend both **class meetings** and all day on the **Psy.D. Presentation** date they are scheduled to present their results.
